

Cucumber Trellis

Our Cucumber Trellises make it easy to support cucumbers for better plant health and higher yields. They can also provide shade for lettuce and other heat-sensitive plants. The Medium Cucumber Trellis is 34" wide by 48" high and fits inside our 3' x 3' and 3' x 6' ft beds. The Large Cucumber Trellis measures 48" square after assembly.

Assembly

Slide the two Trellis Panels together using the extended rods at the top and bottom of the inside edge of the Panels. Use the two opposing clips along the edge to snap the Panels together.

To attach the legs to the assembled panels, follow the diagrams (Steps 1 to 5, at right.) Press the legs 4" to 6" into the ground adjust the Trellis so that it is angled, as shown.

NOTE: In windy areas, we recommend anchoring it to the ground or to a post to keep the wind from pulling it off the ground and your plants along with it.

Plant cucumber seeds or transplants at the bottom of the trellis and train them onto the support as they grow.

Maintenance

To prolong the life of your trellis, we recommend storing it under cover at the end of the season. If the powdercoated finished is nicked, touch it up with exterior paint or polyurethane to prevent rust.
