Oxford Arch

This Arch has a classic design that fits in with any landscape or decor. It's sturdy enough to support your favorite annual and perennial vines.

Parts

- (2) Bottom Side Panels
- (2) Top Side Panels
- (2) Arches
- (5) Braces
- (4) Stakes

Recommended Tools

- Rubber Mallet
- Stepladder

Assembly

NOTE: Assembly requires two people. The pieces of the Arch are heavy. Please be careful when handling them.

Step 1. We recommend assembling the arch where you intend to install it. Select a location that is protected from high winds and is away from children's play areas. **NOTE:** Because the Arch is heavy, we recommend securing it in concrete. If you are installing it directly into the ground, please make sure your soil is firm.

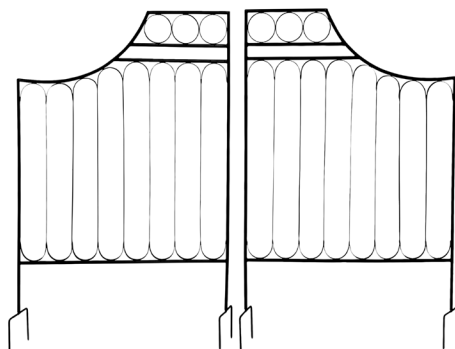
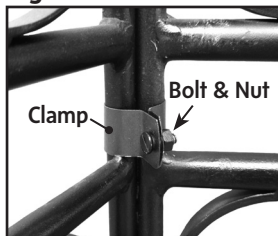
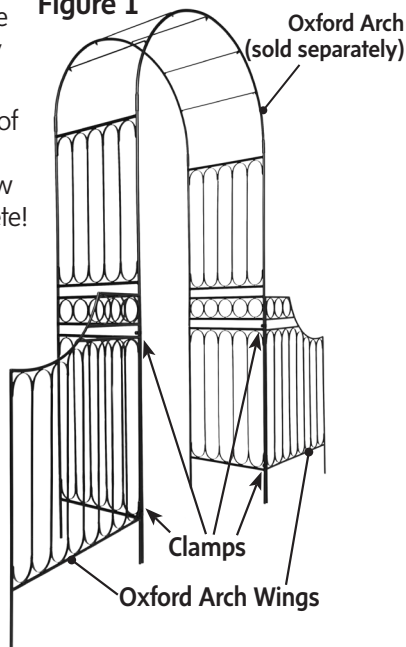


Figure 1



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

Step 2. Slide the hollow ends on the Top Side Panel over the prongs on the Bottom Side Panel (Figure 1). Repeat to assemble the other side of the Arch.

Step 3. Assemble the Arch on the ground by laying the attached Side Panels on their sides, parallel to each other. Examine the Arches to find the attached loops (Figure 2). Slide the ends of the Arches into the openings in the Top Side Panels, with the attached loops facing in.

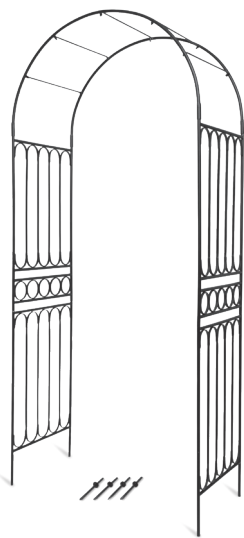
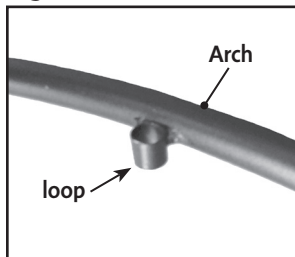
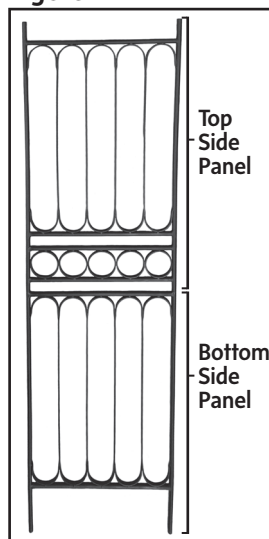

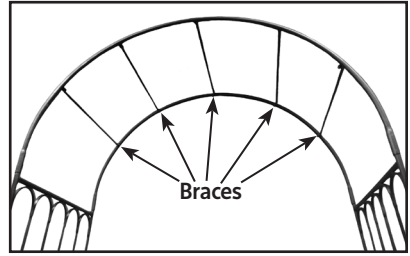

Step 4. With at least two people, carefully lift the Arch so it is upright. Make sure the sides are straight, then press the ends of the Bottom Side Panels into the ground, marking it. Move the Arch to the side and use your rubber mallet to gently pound the Stakes into the marked spots. Place the open ends of the Arch over the tops of the Stakes.

Step 5. Use your stepladder to place the Braces into the loops on the Arches (Figure 3). Your assembly is complete!

The powder-coated steel Arch is weather-resistant and can be left outdoors year-round. However, if the finish is nicked or scratched, use an exterior-grade metal paint to prevent rust.

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Oxford Arch Wings

Add dimension to your Arch with the Oxford Arch Wings. They make the perfect entryway, or can be used as Trellises on their own. They're sturdy enough to support vining plants such as roses and clematis. **NOTE:** The Oxford Arch is sold separately.

Parts

- (2) Wings
- (4) Footed Stakes
- (4) Clamps with Bolts and Nuts

Assembly

NOTE: Assembly is easiest with two people.

Slide the Footed Stakes into the slots on the bottom of the Wings. Arrange the Wings against the ends of the Arch, setting them at whatever angle you like (Figure 1). Position the Stakes so they are perpendicular to the Wings, then push them fully into the ground.

Wrap the Clamps around the top and bottom of the Wings and the Arch (Figures 1 & 2). Place the Bolts through the holes in the Clamps, then screw the Nuts onto the ends. Your assembly is complete!

Care

The powder-coated steel Wings are weather-resistant and can be left outdoors year-round. However, if the finish is nicked or scratched, use an exterior-grade metal paint to prevent rust.
