## Glass Mushroom Solar Light

This whimsical mushroom will add a magical touch to any garden. It provides a bright pop of color during the day and lights up at night for an enchanting display. It's powered by a solar panel, so you only need to set it up once, before enjoying it for the rest of the season. **NOTE:** Each Glass Mushroom is individually hand-blown, making it unique. There will be differences between them.

### Set Up Instructions

The Mushroom Solar Light is very easy to set up. Place the Round Stake into the plastic opening on the bottom of Glass Mushroom and slide the Square Stake into the slot on the bottom of the Solar Panel, as shown in Figure 2. Press the ON/OFF button once to turn it on and place the Solar Panel in a location that gets plenty of sunlight. **Important:** Remove the protective film from the Solar Panel. Place the Glass Mushroom up to 30" away from the Solar Panel. It will automatically turn on when it has a charge and the Solar Panel senses darkness.

### Use and Care Instructions

The performance of your solar light will vary with the time of year and the amount of light that falls on the Solar Panel. It will deliver more light after a full day in the sun than it would after a day in overcast weather or in the shade.

For the best results, place your Solar Panel where sunlight falls directly on it for 8 hours or more. Avoid locations where it will be shaded by buildings or trees. Also avoid locations where the Panel will be affected by sources of artificial nighttime light, such as street lamps. Keep the Solar Panel clean and free of obstructions for maximum light collection.

Store the Glass Mushroom Solar Lights indoors during winter months if you experience cold temperatures, snow or ice.


