



Viva Self-Watering Rolling Planters

These stylish self-watering planters use built-in reservoirs to keep the potting mix moist and reduce watering chores.

Assembly

- Step 1.** Seat the platform into the bottom of the pot by aligning the arrow on top of the platform with the opening in the side of the pot.
- Step 2.** Prepare the potting mix by pre-moistening it. We recommend our Self-Watering Potting Mix, as well as a slow-release granular fertilizer, such as our 5-5-5 All-Purpose Fertilizer. The small planters hold 24 quarts of mix. The large round planter holds 40 quarts of mix and the large square planter holds 55 quarts.
- Step 3.** Fill the Planter with prepared planting mix to within 2" to 3" of the top edge. Add your plants or seeds and additional planting mix, if needed.
- Step 4.** Water the pot from the top to thoroughly moisten the soil and settle the plant roots or seeds. Fill the water reservoir by pouring water into the water fill hole in the side of the planter. Maintain even soil moisture either by watering from the top or by filling the reservoir through the fill hole.

Care and Maintenance

Check the soil moisture regularly by looking into the water fill hole to see the water level or inserting your finger. Daily inspection may be necessary, especially if you live in a hot, dry climate or experience extended periods of dry weather. Plants will use more water as they grow larger.

Empty the reservoir or move the planter indoors prior to freezing weather to avoid damage to the pot.

About Drainage: The fill hole acts as a reservoir overflow, allowing excess water to drain. We recommend this planter for outdoor use only.
