

Leaf Wall Trellis



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Hanging Hardware for Wall Installation

Screws and anchors are not included since the type of hardware you need will depend on the type of wall you're installing it to. **NOTE:** Remember to include the weight of your plants when choosing hardware.

Installation

NOTE: The Leaf pattern is made to be continuous, so you can install one Trellis on top of another.

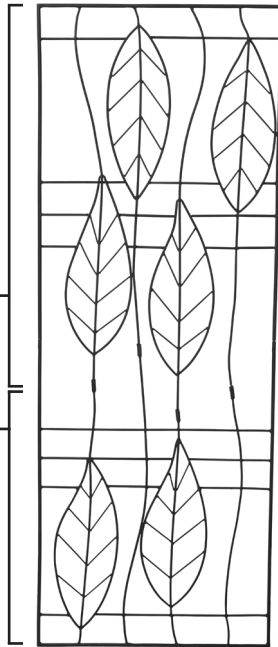
Step 1. Slide the TOP and BOTTOM TRELLIS SECTIONS together. If you are installing it into the ground or only installing one trellis on your wall, place PLUGS into the two top holes.

Place PLUGS into the top and bottom openings on the TRELLIS SECTIONS if they are not being used.

Step 3. Attach the remaining WALL BRACKETS so the hooks are supporting the TOP TRELLIS SECTION. Your assembly is complete!

Step 2. Installing into the ground: Slide the STAKES into the open slots on the bottom of the TRELLIS and insert it directly into the ground. Your assembly is complete!

Step 2. Installing on your wall: Place PLUGS into the open spots on the bottom of the TRELLIS. Install two WALL BRACKETS 20" apart at the height you want the bottom of your TRELLIS to be, then sit the trellis on top of them.

The Leaf Wall Trellis can left outdoors year-round. If the powder-coated finish gets nicked or scratched, use an exterior-grade metal paint to prevent rust.

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
