

Vertex Lifetime Tall Tomato Cage

You're going to love this tomato cage! It's strong, lightweight, offers plenty of room for harvesting, is built to last and is perfect for tomatoes that grow up to 6' tall. The aluminum rods won't rust and the connectors are durable and UV-resistant.

Parts List

- (1) Bottom Cage with legs
- (1) Top Cage
- (5) Clips
- (4) Silicone Tubes

Installation and Care instructions

NOTE: The Vertex Lifetime Tall Tomato Cage should be installed in firm soil. It is not intended to be used in loose soils such as sand.

Step 1. Wrap the Cage around your tomato plant but do not seat the legs fully into the ground. Using the 2 Clips, secure the opening. Place each clip between two rods, centering them vertically, then twist until the rods snap into the indents (Figure 1). The clips are designed to have a tight fit and will need to be pressed firmly into place.

Step 2. Connect the upper rods with the Silicone Tubes (Figure 2).

Step 3. Slide the receptacles on the Top Cage over the prongs on the Lower Cage (Figure 3).



Step 4. Repeat Step 1 to attach the loose sides of the Upper Cage with the remaining 3 Clips (Figure 1). Push the legs all the way into the ground.

Your Cage will sway slightly in high winds. This will help your plant develop a strong stem. At the end of your season, just remove the Cage from the ground and fold it flat for easy storage. If you ever need to remove a Clip, we recommend using needle-nose pliers to hold the bottom of the Clip and lift it up (Figure 4).
