Tabletop Microgreen Hydroponic Garden Kit

Savor the fresh flavor of microgreens in any season with the Tabletop Microgreen Hydroponic Garden Kit. It fits handily on your kitchen counter and includes everything you need to get started. It even comes with 2 packets of High Mowing Organic microgreen seeds: Purple Sango and Arugula. With its built timer and water level sensor, all you need to do is wait for your microgreens to grow!

Parts List

- (1) LED Grow Light
- (1) Basin
- (2) Growing Pods with Grid Covers, Foam Inserts and Planting Medium
- (1) Power Cord
- (2) Seed Packets: Purple Sango and Arugula

Assembly

Step 1. Remove the Grid Covers from the Growing Pods. Lift up on the tabs on the Foam Inserts to remove them (Figure 1). You can dispose of the Foam Inserts.

Step 2. Sprinkle a healthy pinch of seeds into each Growing Pod and gently mix them into the top layer of the planting medium. Replace the Grid Covers.

Step 3. Remove one of the Growing Pods from the Basin to reveal the water reservoir inside. Use a cup to fill the reservoir up to the marker shown in Figure 2. Replace the Growing Pod.

Step 4. Slide the LED Grow Light into the slot on the side of the Basin (Figure 3). Plug the Power Cord into the Grow Light and then into your power outlet.

Step 5. Turn on the Light by pressing the button at the end of the Light (Figure 4). The Light Settings are:

- Press the button once to turn on the white reading light.
- Press the button twice to change to the red and white growing light.
- Press the button again to turn off the light.
- To turn on the timer, press and hold the on/off button. This will start the timer at 16 hours on, 8 hours off.

Now all you have to do is wait!

NOTE: When the water level is low, the Hydroponic Garden will start to beep and the water level light will flash red. Follow Step 3 to refill the water reservoir.

Harvesting Instructions

Check your seed packet to see the growing time for your microgreens. When it is time to harvest, use scissors to trim off the tops of the greens. Wash them with water and dry with a paper towel or salad spinner. You should serve them immediately or store them in a plastic bag in your refrigerator.

The included Planting Medium can be reused. Remove the Grid Covers and pull out as many of the microgreen roots as you can. Add new seeds to the Growing Pod and mix them into the top layer of planting medium. **NOTE:** You can find new planting medium at your local gardening store. We recommend using vermiculite.

Safety and Care Instructions

Keep your Hydroponic Garden on a sturdy, level surface that won't be damaged by water. For the best results, we recommend you choose a spot that gets indirect sunlight and won't be affected by hot or cold sources.

Important: The Hydroponic Garden should be kept out of the reach of children and pets. Only plug it into a standard electrical outlet.

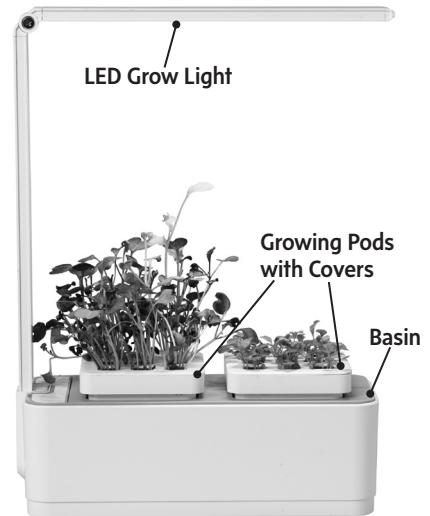

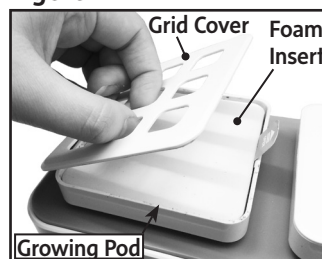

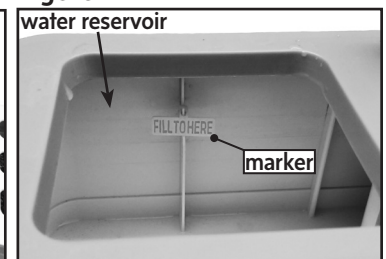

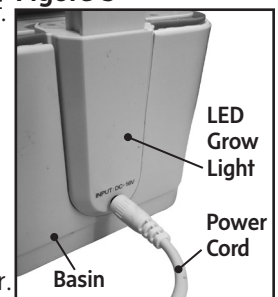
