BULB BASKET CARE

Upon Arrival

- Open the box immediately to allow for air circulation and to bring your bulb garden to room temperature.
- Water the basket thoroughly and place it in a brightly lit space.
- If you cannot care for your plants for a day or two, place the open box in a dark, cool (non-freezing) location.
- Don't worry if sprouts appear yellow or bent — they'll straighten and turn a healthy green in a few days.

Care

- Rotate the basket every few days to keep plants growing straight.
- Water as needed to keep soil moist but not wet.
- Different bulb varieties will bloom at different times.
- When the buds start to open, move the basket to a cool spot (60–70° F) out of direct sunlight to prolong blooming.



Bulbs will start blooming in succession within just a few weeks. Bloom times vary and can be affected by bulb variety, room temperature and light levels.
