Nocturne Wall Trellis

The Nocturne Wall Trellis makes a striking statement with its aged bronze finish on the outside and brass foil finish on the inside. It's available in both a left and right version, sold individually.

Assembly and Care

NOTE: Assembly is easiest with two people.

Line up the design on the two Panels before sliding the hollow ends on the Top Panel over the prongs on the Bottom Panel. Then choose a location to install your Trellis, either directly into your garden or against a wall.

Installing in the Ground

We recommend choosing a location that is protected from high winds and is away from children's play areas.

NOTE: If you are not placing your Trellis against a wall, it must be installed in firm soil. If you have loose or sandy soil, we recommend securing the Trellis in concrete.

Slide the Footed Stakes into the slots on the Bottom Panel. Position the Stakes so they are perpendicular to the trellis and push them fully into the ground.

Installing on a Wall

Important: We have included wood screws for the Wall Brackets. If you are attaching the Trellis to any surface other than wood, please provide your own fasteners.

Install two Brackets 21-22" apart, at the height you want the Bottom of your Trellis to sit. Make sure the hooks are facing up and sit the Bottom Panel on top of them. Attach the remaining Wall Brackets so the hooks are supporting the Top Panel.

The powder-coated steel Trellis is weather-resistant and can be left outdoors year-round. However, if the finish is nicked or scratched, use an exterior-grade metal paint to prevent rust.
