Cedar Compost Bin

Our Cedar Compost Bin makes it easy to compost in your own backyard! It's made from durable cedar and aluminum, and has ventilated sides that aerate your compost pile from all sides. The hinged lid allows you to easily add food scraps, while the front door makes it easy to remove finished compost. It even includes a lock to help keep pests out.

Parts

- (1) Front Panel with Door and Corners
- (1) Back Panel with Corners
- (2) Side Panels
- (1) Lid with Door
- (4) Corners
- (4) Corner Caps
- (36) Screws

Tools needed

- Screw gun with Phillips bit
- Rubber mallet (optional)




Assembly

NOTE: Assembly is easiest with 2 people. We recommend assembling your Compost Bin in the spot you plan to keep it.

Step 1. Stand both the Front and Back Panels upright, with the open channels in the Corners facing inward. Slide a Side Panel into the open channels with the wooden supports facing the inside of the Composter (Figure 1). Make sure the tops of the Panels are flush and secure them together by inserting a Screw through each predrilled hole in the Corner attached to the Back Panel and the top 5 holes in the Corner attached to the Front Panel.

Step 2. Open the Door on the Front Panel by unlocking the Barrel Lock, lifting up on the Handle and pressing it into the Clip (Figure 2). **NOTE:** You need to press hard on the Handle to push it into the Clip, especially the first time. With the Door open, insert Screws through the remaining 4 holes in the Front Corner (Figure 3).

Step 3. Repeat Steps 1 & 2 to attach the remaining Side Panel.

Step 4. Insert a Corner Cap into the top of each aluminum Corner, using a rubber mallet if necessary. Place the Lid on top of the Compost Bin with the Door near the front. Your assembly is complete!

The Cedar Compost Bin holds over 16 cu. ft. (13-½ bushels) of compost.



